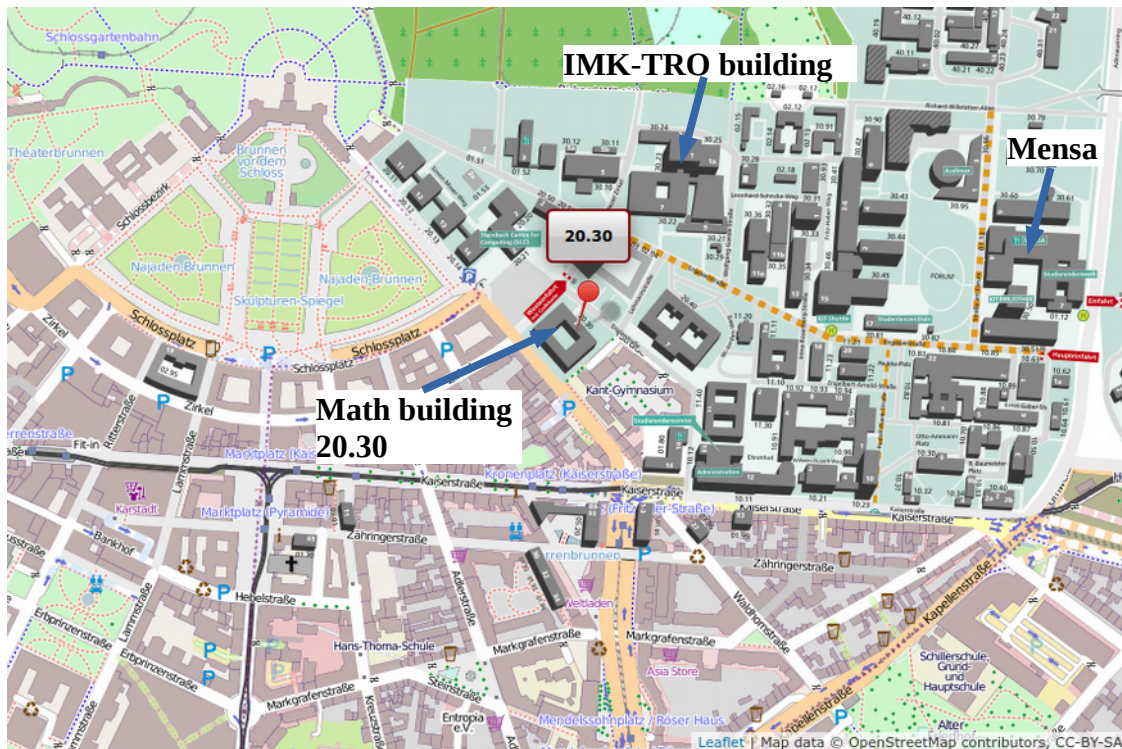

Logistics
